

Anti-Israel pamphlet referred to law officer

The Attorney-General is investigating the latest pamphlet produced by the fictitious organisation, Anglo-Hebrew Publishing. The pamphlet includes an appeal for donations to combat the "cancer of Zionism."

The violently anti-Israel pamphlet, entitled "Charity begins at home," has been distributed to a small number of Jewish people in the London area.

An accompanying letter appeals for sympathy for the Dowager Lady Birdwood, who was found guilty in 1991 of distributing anti-Jewish leaflets intended to stir up racial hatred.

Mike Whine, defence director of the Board of Deputies, told the JC that the leaflet had been passed on to the Attorney-General.

In May, Anglo-Hebrew Publishing distributed a hoax letter requesting donation to Jewish homes in London.
