# BNP GIRL: WHY DIDN'T CABBIE KILL MIGRANTS?

## Jibes spark anger

BNP activist Charlotte Lewis sparked fury last night by saying Derrick Bird should have killed illegal immigrants.

Lewis, 37, wrote on her Facebook page that she wished that the Taxi Terminator, who shot dead 12 people in Cumbria and wounded 11, had headed to London instead.

Lewis, who stood at the General Election, said: "OK, so I may well get in to trouble for saying this but I've got to get it off my chest. I wish that Derrick Bird could have come down to London and shot dead some illegal immigrants rather than killing his fellow British people."

"If that offends you then tough, it's my opinion and I'm entitled to it."

Her crackpot comments, came on the day Bird's victims Kenneth Fishburn and Susan Hughes were buried.

Last night a relative of the Bird family said: "She must be stark raving bonkers."

"Surely the only sensible thing to say after something like this is it would have been better if Derrick had not killed anyone at all."

"Some of the victims are not even buried yet. But she is trying to score some kind of sick political point. It's totally insensitive."

"She should be prosecuted for race hatred."

### Charged

A friend of cabbie Darren Rewcastle, 43, who was shot dead on his Whitehaven taxi rank, said: "This is a disgusting thing to say."

"It makes light of what was a massive tragedy."

"If she'd lost one of her friends or relatives she might not have been so quick to spout off."

Anti-fascist organisation Searchlight called for Lewis to be charged with inciting racial hatred.

Spokesman Gerry Gable said: "I think anybody advocating the murder of illegal immigrants should be prosecuted."

"People may view Charlotte Lewis as being a bit potty but the overwhelming interest in firearms of the BNP tells a much more serious story."

It is not the first time Lewis, who stood as BNP parliamentary candidate for Carshalton and Wallington, Surrey, has sparked outrage.

Earlier this year she dressed in a Muslim burka and posed for raunchy snaps as she downed bottles of booze.
