

W.A.A.F. FAKES RAPE STORY

ADELAIDE, Thurs—A young WAAF admitted in the Police Court today that she had concocted a story to the police of having been attacked and raped on Monday night because she was frantic with worry about her pregnancy.

Aircraftwoman Audrey Sarah Dorwood (22), pleaded guilty to having made a false report.

She collapsed after the magistrate refused her counsel's plea to suppress her name from publication.

Miss Dorwood was fined £3/7/6 and in addition was ordered to pay £4/3/11 costs of police investigations.

The prosecutor said that Dorwood told a fellow WAAF that she had been attacked and raped by a civilian while crossing a paddock near the baths.

A similar story was told to a policewoman.

Police decided that the story was untrue and Dorwood broke down and cried.

She then told the police: "I am six weeks pregnant and when I told a flight-sergeant that he was responsible for my condition he denied it.

"I then became almost mad with worry and didn't know what to do"
