I've something to ask you. The 1991 Sex Maniac's Diary will open with Statements and Manifestos from various groups. I feel that I've given the swingers plenty of space to explain where they are at, but other groups have been left unexplained. I wonder if I could include a short paragraphy from NCROPA, stating the situation in Britain and how you fight it. You have some lovely catch phrases (Faschist Fanatical Feminists, etc) and I'm sure you could whack it to the readers effectively. You'd probably gain some more members and also might make some impact UP THERE as the Diary is read by a few influential people.

I think the paragraph could include an explanation of why politians chicken out of supporting anti-censorship campaigns and something to the effect that women and children in Europe are not harmed by the liberal laws in Holland and Germany.

I wish I could do more to help you but I'm personally so overloaded with the Outsiders which is always broke and the Diary which is suffering from the recession, that I cannot write many letters or do extra work.
