ANSWERS FEBRUARY

I have been writing a book on sexually explicit materials for some time and I am concerned about the law and sexually explicit materials.

I was the NCROPA A.G.M., but had to leave early and so was unable to talk to you. I wondered if you could clarify a few things for me:

From the meeting I understand the position is as follows:

A). A person can legally own hardcore sexually explicit materials, provided minors are not in any way involved. Are there any other limitations, e.g. anal/animals? NO SEF B). One may not have any sexually explicit materials of a hard core nature in order to (with the intention of) making a profit from them.

C) If written/visual hardcore materials are brought through customs, and you are caught, they are not likely to worry about one or magazines. SORRETT-SEE

D) If customs seize a video the D). If customs seize a video they can, and probably will, use the Criminal Justice Bill

to search your house, on the grounds that videos can easily be copied for profit.

I have two further questions, in addition to that under point 1) above.

1. How does the law, as interpreted, stand on CD's? I assume that since they are not able to be copied, one would be within the law to own them. Could you bring them through customs? NO .
