EIDOS

Eidos is a Greek word meaning form. It also an acronym for:

Everyone Is Doing Outrageous Sex.

It is a unique erotic tabloid publication.

I'll review Eidos fully next issue, but suffice to say that it is a publication of sexual freedom and erotic entertainment for women, men and couples.

Eidos features erotic fiction, non-fiction, poetry, news, erotica and secular humanism. The 84 huge pages of the current issue also feature lots of very interesting personal small ads and display ads – and the photographs and drawings are pretty good as well!

They are looking for "cutting edge, avant garde, progressive, provocative, erotica, depicting respectful, consensual images of the human form – sensual, sexual, explicit – as a liberating experience for all traditionally oppressed sexual minorities."

Humorous or tongue-in-cheek erotic fiction is especially wanted.

The fiction should be honest, explicitly pro-sex, depicting mutually consensual erotica.

Stories shouldn't feature unwanted power, control, and degradation – no rape or coercion of any kind.

As for erotic poetry, they do not want angry poetry, or poetry that is demeaning to either men or women.

They want erotic poetry which makes "a personal, political, or cultural statement about sensu-sexuality". If you can write honest, literate, erotica and wish to make a personal statement within your writing about sexual freedom of expression, then *Edios* is for you.

The Editor and Publisher of *Eidos* is Brenda Loew Tatelbaum, who says:

"Pornography doesn't do anything for me. I like erotica – photos of real people doing the *real* thing. Erotica is a celebration of sexuality, which is life affirming."

That has to be one of the better definitions of erotica that we've heard.

Send them a ms or a letter, and they'll get back to you within 4-8 weeks.

Mss should be no longer than 2,000 words. They accept unsolicited submissions. If you want ms back send sae or IRC's

Payment is a copy of Eidos.

We don't usually advocate submitting material unless you get paid when published.

Eidos is an exception. It is circulated to 54 countries and is highly influential.

Next issue is due out in the Spring.

Our usual advice coming up: Read a publication before you submit material, that's if you want to get a real feel of what they are after.

In the case of *Eidos*, a single issue is \$15; or four issues on subscription for \$55. They take Mastercard. or else it is \$\$\$ dollars cash only. In the USA as in the UK, the banks come close to extortion when changing small foreign cheques.

Joanna Payne & Edward Shanks from Erotic Stories



Joanna Payne was plucked from a successful career as an author of short erotic fiction to edit *Erotic Stories Magazine*. Even when heavily bribed she refuses to reveal any of her pseudonyms from that period – on the grounds it might incriminate her!

Their tip for successful erotic writing: it should turn the author on, as well as the intended audience. "Writing erotic fiction is fun," they say.

"It's not work and we pay you for it."

Edwards Shanks began his writing career at school selling erotica to his classmates at a pound a page. Later, at university, he successfully defended his right to publish a number of erotic poems and short stories in his magazine Literarie. He joined ES two years ago after editing an epistolary novella entitled Secret Letters of a Victorian Madam.

This wildly decadent and totally original book starts with a Prince having anal sex with his girlfriend in the Royal horse drawn carriage which is parked in the middle of the market square.

The Prince sees three girls teasing a naked man who is imprisoned in the stocks. The girls cover the man's penis with flour and masturbate him to the cheers of the watching crowd. This is the sort of diversion they like on market day.

This is a bawdy version of Cinderella. The Prince has a shoe and foot fetish second to none in the Kingdom, and everybody else from the butler to the Lords and Ladies wouldn't know what straight sex was if it jumped up and bit them in the backside.

In the original Cinderella, the fairy godmother turned a pumpkin into a coach. In this one, the Godmother masturbates a giant's penis by whipping it and where the ejaculate lands so the coach appears. The Godmother is naked apart from sexy shoes — but you guessed that! The police protect the rich, and the poor have to fend for themselves. No it isn't a modern day romance – this is set some time in the future.

Fee's husband is a mega-rich businessman more interested in closing a deal than bonking. She goes to the crumbling city which is ruled by a gang of outlaws and indulges in rough trade sex with the leader of the gang, fights his girl friend, is screwed by his brother while in chains – just an average Away Day trip to the big city.

Fee steals a computer, starts her own business, fakes a rape, screws the police captain, visits a massage parlour, watches two men screw, helps her husband run a business moving water from one part of the country to another – but is still bored!

She visits a brothel and watches a live show – where a lady does an impossible thing with a robot snake – seduces the maid, then sexually introduces the maid to her husband, and a threesome develops.

The chief outlaw turns up at Fee's door. She hides him in the attic. He looks through a hole and sees Fee and the maid and the husband. Ignore the plot, and buy it for the expertly written sex scenes.

The Phallus of Osiris

A story of vampirism and the occult. It takes the form of a quest; the missing item being the phallus of the title. Purportedly based on Egyptian mythology, the tale is revealed mainly through the eyes of Mara Fleming, a modern-day white witch.

Her protagonist is The Master, a vampire sorcerer who feeds and grows on human sexual energy, and who needs the phallus to restore life to his long-dead Queen, Sedet. His spirit seeks out the highly sensual psychic Mara to help liberate both himself and his Queen. Mara's lover, journalist Andreas Hunt, becomes a victim of the Master's magic, resulting in The Master taking over his body. After that it gets complicated...

Is it a good book? It is certainly well written in the main, although the dialogue becomes archaic in places, even banal occasionally. There is no doubt that Valentina Cilescu is an accomplished writer, with an occasional nice turn of phrase. For example, as in one character's description of an avenger: "Destruction does not always present itself with a fiery sword. Sometimes it has firm breasts and a tight, wet cunt".

Unfortunately, there is not nearly enough of this, and the more one delves into the pages the more cliched and repetitive the descriptions of the sex scenes become. To be fair however, the book is over 300 pages long and with couplings of one form or another on practically every page, it takes one hell of an imagination to maintain originality.

There is also a feeling of the tail wagging the dog. The plot, (a good one incidentally), gets sidelined more often than not. Every move Mara makes seems designed to tumble her into another hectic round of orgies, rapes and general debauchery......whether relevant to the story or not.

If this is to your taste, then you will enjoy it. Not a book for the squeamish though...

This book is about astrology and women's sexual fantasies.

The first few pages of the book give a nice, clear explanation of astrology, and then it examines each star sign individually and with each star sign comes a real life fantasy. Real in the sense that this isn't made up fiction. The author interviewed many women and has recorded their deepest sexual fantasies.

There is one fantasy per star sign, but some of the women manage to get several sub-plots within each fantasy. The fantasies range from average erotic to humiliation to women on top scenarios. As you would expect from fantasies, anything goes. Just about every single avenue of sexual behaviour is covered.

It well produced, very well written, and has a real touch of class. A nice touch is how, at the end of each fantasy, the author puts the fantasy into perspective with the star sign.

If you are not interested in star igns then you should still get this book, for it gives a very good insight into what some women think re sex and men.

If you are a male writer and are considering writing an erotic novel told from a woman's point of view, then this book could be a useful resource manual.

Read this book, find out what sexual fantasies real women are having, and you will improve your own writing.

Helen Henley has written extensively about her particular fetish both in fact and fiction. In this book she tells her personal story of sexual discovery; a voyage into a world of rubber fetish and bondage. She tells her story with candour, humour, and insight. She says in the forward fetishism involving rubber does exist, so does bondage and restriction. They are not inventions of the human mind. A bizarre manifestation of human sexual behaviour certainly, but disabling and harmful certainly not".

I read the book carefully, not knowing too much about this scene. What comes over is that the ritual seems to be almost as important at times as \$ the actual sex.

"Preparation was stimulating, dressing was the foreplay, then the slow performance of nakedness into disguise, the rolling on of the skin tight suits, gloves – pushing and pressing each finger in turn..." There is a great deal of ritual in the book, a lot of sex much thought and in the book, the sliding and slipping into head helmets, the a lot of sex, much thought and introspection, and much, much honesty.

In this book you will not find erotica for the sake of it, though erotica there is in plenty; this is a true account of a woman realising what her needs were and coming to terms with those needs. I suppose also coming to terms with the fact that the rest of the world considered those needs to be a fetish, and not a 'normal' fetish at that.

Now I've read the book I understand this fetish a little more. It doesn't do anything for me, but who is right and who is wrong and what is normal? What does normal mean?

The setting is the future. Women have become pleasure chattels, controlled, trained, and sold by the State. Some become pets of the rich. A woman, unless one of the privileged will, in 2477 spend most of her adult life restrained, used, and abused. This book is about a woman who was one of the privileged few and who has accidentally fallen foul of the law. The training is imaginative and unusual, to say the least. The court room scene and the 'quivering female cross' are just two of the many set pieces that will keep bondage fans happy.

Educating Roger by 'Anonymous'

Review of both the above books by Duncan Richards. His work has appeared in Erotic Stories, and his almost completed novel is attracting much interest.

If, like me, you've spent too much time festering over your sub/dom masterpiece then the mainstream Lady Rakehell will come as welcome light relief, a sort of lemon sorbet to a jaded palate. Plot? Well actually this one does have a plot, too much of a plot in my opinion, which ultimately leaves the delicious but scheming heroine Alicia all tied up in little lacy knots of the author's creation.

She doesn't want to become the company whore, but can't see any other way to ratchet her dullard husband Warren up the corporate ladder. Alicia has to work hard to keep up with the demands of her husband's mentors, while at the same time appeasing his would be nemesis, Corinne Leslie, and she finds her talents stretched to the limit.

The question is what will Warren say if he finds out about her back stage manoeuvrings? I couldn't understand what she saw in the bloke. Fortunately, the writer is skillful enough to give the girl a new outfit for each scene and a different coloured pair of panties to be ripped off on every page, thus the psychological dilemma is resolved!

A few quibbles; 'enormous growth' is not an attractive description of the erect male member, and 'crevice' and 'cavity' are disconcerting alternatives to that other 'c-word'; what are we talking about here, wall insulation, mountaineering, dentistry or what? By the way, apparently 'frig' is an American spelling for 'fridge', don't get confused; I did, and the Pavlova was ruined!

Following the death of his grandmother, the eponymous hero of **Educating Roger** discovers that he has an aunt in New Orleans, and leaves the bleak religious community where he has been brought up, to join her. After being 'flashed' by some girls in the coach station, and bonked in the back of a Greyhound bus, Roger probably has some idea of what the sex-crazed author of this epic has in store for him.

With the assistance of a raven-haired nymph called Nicole, (no sign of Papa in this one!) Aunt Rachel leads him on a journey of sexual enlightenment without ever having to leave her house! The story requires Roger to be mostly passive during the first half of the book, but it is soon apparent that he has 'a good instinct for dirty sex, and knicker fetishism', and before long the pupil is setting the agenda for his teacher. Towards the end there is a nicely described 'anal initiation' for Nicole, with a few helpful hints for us poor saps who still plough the missionary furrow.

It all ends with Roger taking charge and, using an oversized phallus named *le formidable* and just a little bit of bondage, proving that 'Girls On Top' was only an eighties sitcom after all! A wholly satisfactory outcome in the opinion of this reviewer.

Two highly recommended books. Educating Roger being my favourite for its tougher, more explicit content, but I'll be dreaming about the lovely Alicia for some time to come. If you're out there now Alicia, 'phone home darling, Daddy's waiting for your call.



If that's the response to a polite request what will they say to a manuscript query?

Give them a miss with your erotic mss. Stick with Headline and Black Lace and Little Brown and Nexus and all the other nice friendly people who understand the word courtesy.

EROTIC STORIES have a deadline of March 9th for stories with an 'entertainment theme'. We said last issue we'd give you some advice on this.

Don't go for the obvious. Many writers will submit stories about fantasy bonking with television or film personalities or rock stars. Think about the whole world of entertainment: there is the casting couch, there are drama and dancing and ballet schools; there is strip tease and live sex clubs and topless telegrams - they all come under 'entertainment'.
