Dear Colleague,

As a Trade Union official you will have no doubt been approached by an organisation named Searchlight, appealing for your support in their fight against Racism and Fascism.

Before you or your organisation give any support, financial or otherwise, to this group, we feel it is vital that you know just who you are dealing with.

Searchlight claims to be dedicated to fighting Racism and Fascism. In this, and this alone, they are somewhat truthful but, it is their tactics, motives and own record in this field that cause alarm.

TACTICS

Searchlight boasts of "exposing and driving out" nationalists from their workplaces. If the Tories didn't do enough to create unemployment in this country, now we have a group who describe themselves as "left of centre" trying hard to increase the already substantial unemployment figures. Yes, it is true that Searchlight has caused people to lose their jobs, just because Searchlight disapproves of their political opinions!

Another favoured tactic is the publishing of political opponents home addresses. This tactic was first developed in the early 1960s by the then editor, Morris Ludmer. The practice was described as "scurrilous" by a Birmingham magistrate, who realised that the objective was to incite violence and harassment to those *Searchlight* had selected as victims. From *Searchlight's* perspective, this tactic has been extremely successful. Political opponents have been subjected to criminal damage to their homes and cars, arson attacks with petrol poured though letter-boxes in the dead of night, with no thought of the risk to wives and children asleep in bed. Homes and cars have been fire-bombed, and even physical attacks of extreme violence on political opponents are not unknown. All incited by *Searchlight!*.

WHAT OTHER REASON WOULD THEY HAVE FOR PRINTING A POLITICAL OPPONENTS HOME ADDRESS?

We use the term "political opponents" reservedly. For not all of Searchlight's victims have been racists, fascists or neo-nazi's. Tories, "Greens", Anarchists and Libertarians have all suffered from Searchlight's tactics of terror! In fact anybody who opposes Searchlight is likely to suffer as a result!

We believe that harassment, and incitement to violence has no place in the Trade Union movement.

Searchlight's tactics should be condemned by Trade Unionists of all political persuasion.

This photograph was published in the October 1994 issue of Searchlight. Within two weeks of it appearing petrol was pored through the letter-box and ignited. A woman and two young children narrowly escaped with their lives. Would you, as a Trade Union official, support such attacks?

Searchlight's "OTHER" face.

Whilst Searchlight hides behind an carefully constructed cloak of respectability, mixing with Labour MP's, prominent members of the Board of Deputies of British Jews and even senior police officers, there is strong evidence of Searchlight's close connections with terrorist organisations and convicted criminals.

Indeed, while Searchlight speakers address fringe meetings of the TUC and the Labour Party on their perception of the "neo-nazi threat in Britain and Europe" Searchlight supporters are busy conducting a campaign of harassment, criminal damage and physical assault on all that dare hold a different political opinion from that permitted by this nefarious organisation

Recent incidents of Searchlight inspired violence include:

- * Campaigns of harassment against victims at their places of work.
- * Demonstrations outside the homes of victims, and attacks on their property.
- * An arson attack on the home of a political opponent whilst his wife and two children were asleep in bed.
- * A petrol bomb thrown at the front door of another victim.
- * A campaign of terror against a victim and his young family was so intense that they were forced to move home for their own safety.

Even then, Searchlight revealed their new location so as to continue the harassment

All of these incidents were the direct result of Searchlight's policy of "exposing" those they perceive as "political opponents".



This man is a former member of the Socialist Workers Party and in the 70's was active in the left-wing *Big Flame* organisation. Today his politics continue to be "left of centre", and he is active both within his trade union and the *Green Anarchist Movement*.

When he voiced his opinion that Searchlight were not sympathetic to the left, but were instead exploiting workers for their own prestige and financial gain he became a victim of Searchlight's revenge.

A photograph was taken at the school where he works and details of his work-place were published.


This old proverb is very appropriate when you closely examine the "track record" of some of Searchlight's "friends" and staff.

- * The magazine's current editor, Gerry Gable, was convicted in 1964 of an offence under the theft act!
- In an internal memo issued on May 2nd 1977, Gerry Gable admitted having links with the state security services. Yes, the same people who tried to disrupt the miners strike.
- * In 1974, Searchlight named a Miss Sonia Hochfelder, as being a member of the National Front. In 1994, she is described as the "Executive Director of the Searchlight Educational Trust"!.
- In every issue of Searchlight over a two year period, a large part of the magazine's back page carried advertisements, including contact addresses, for "Anti-Fascist Action", a group who advocate and practice "extreme physical violence" against political opponents of both the right and the left!
- * Speakers from Searchlight have also shared platforms with members of "Red Action" a group which openly supports the IRA and, currently has three members serving long prison terms for terrorist bombings in London.
