

Although it dates from the 19th Century, the maxim that there are lies, damned lies and statistics

has never been truer. This saying is often attributed to Benjamin Disraeli, although a little

research reveals there is no credible evidence that he actually said it. Likewise the latest claims

about the extent of child sexual abuse, rape and other unspeakable crimes in these islands have no

Her coping mechanisms included anorexia and self-harming, she suffered terrible flashbacks and agoraphobia, and she had tried to kill herself a number of times" and on and on, *und so weiter*.

If Jane had indeed tried to kill herself a number of times but had failed every single time in addition to being raped everywhere she lived and worked, then clearly she is one of life's failures as well as the unluckiest woman who never existed, but where is all this leading? How about to 58 counselling sessions at a Rape Crisis centre? She is said to be one of no fewer than 52,000 women and girls who are counselled every year in addition to another 60,000 *survivors* who are attended by phone, text and e-mail.

have carried out these crimes in a building crawling with police officers and other security staff?


