But before you shell out ten pounds sterling for this worthless paperback, you might like to check out one of his videos on this and related subjects. Start with this one, which covers 9/11 and many other conspiracies, including the non-conspiracy of the Kennedy Assassination. This year, Ve set up the Conscious Consumer Network to supplement her other project, Freedom Central.
