In this liberated age, anything between consenting adults in private goes. Well, in the West anyway, and almost anything. What though if the adult can't consent because she is dead? This is what a man currently on trial for murder in Wales is alleged to have done.

Christopher May is a former butcher who is alleged to have put his skills to an unspeakable use. May met 47 year old Tracey Woodford in a public house last April. They left together, and she was never seen alive again. When police searched his premises after being alerted by the victim's family, they found body parts in his shower. Finally, the crimes of Gayle Newland are no laughing matter; when a woman goes to bed with a man she is entitled to wake up next to one. In one of the most bizarre criminal trials of the year, she was accused of raping another woman by posing as a man and using a prosthetic penis in lieu of a real one. In September, Newland was convicted only of three counts of sexual assault, but this month she received an eight year sentence at Chester Crown Court. This may sound harsh, but although her victim was not physically damaged as are many rape victims, one can only wonder at the psychological effect this must have had on her.
