In Wales, last week, a young woman was **cleared by a jury** after a week long trial. Taylor Mcdonnell killed an elderly couple on a village road two years ago. The prosecution case was that she had been using a mobile phone, but Miss Mcdonnell said she had been using a hands-free phone, and

although she was talking to her grandfather at the time, she had not been distracted. In spite of her acquittal, this case has led to calls for the law to be changed. The victims, Denis and Joyce Drew, were both 86 years old and had been married for 54 years.

The law certainly does need to be changed because on February 4 **it was reported** that a purge by Thames Valley Police had resulted in a staggering seven hundred drivers being fined for using a phone behind the wheel in one week. Perhaps the fine should be quadrupled, or how about putting an offender in the stocks for a day, and for a second offence, confiscate his car?
