

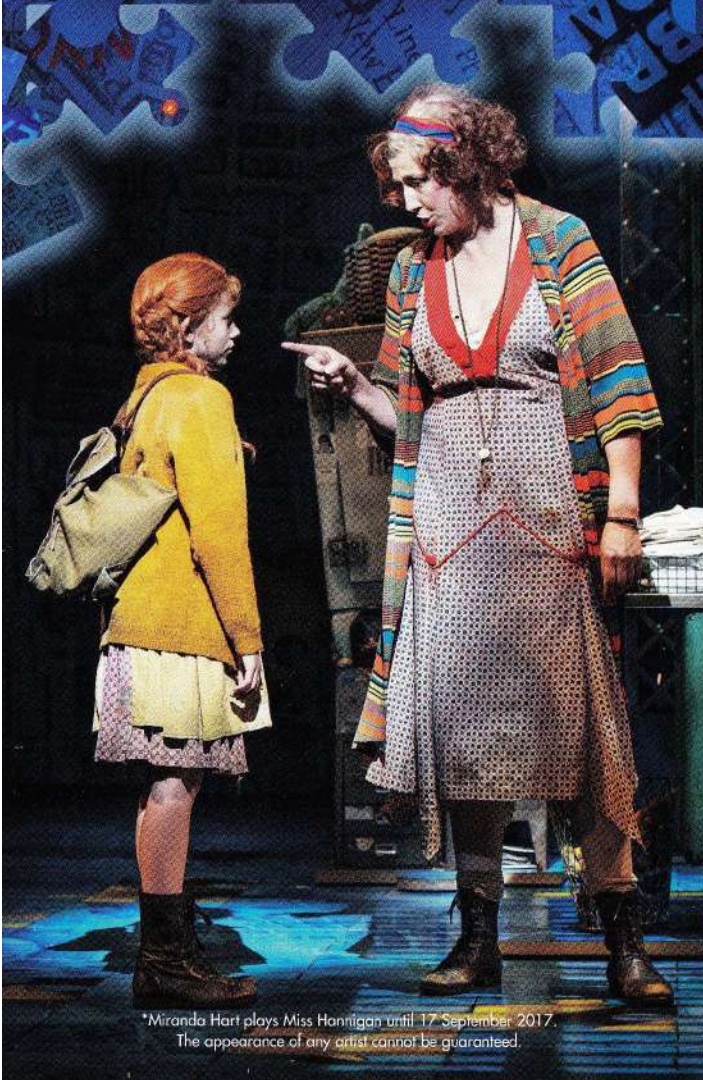
The world's favourite family musical **ANNIE** opened to rave reviews at London's Piccadilly Theatre.

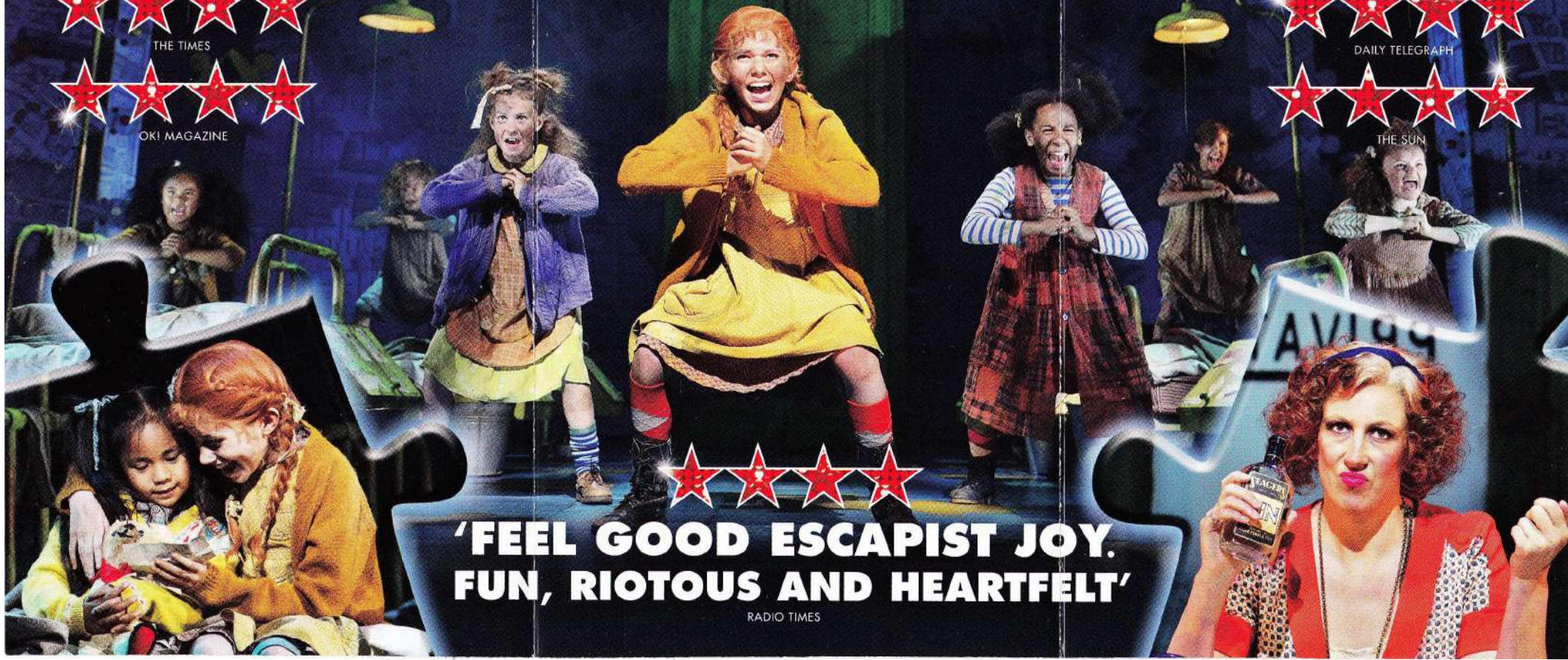
