Following the beautiful production of *The Sound of Music* earlier this year, we return with another Rodgers & Hammerstein classic in a 70th anniversary production of *Oklahoma!* The original Broadway production opened on 31st March 1943, and ran for an unprecedented 2,243 performances. Based on the play *Green Grow the Lilacs*, the musical is set in the old West, which was about to become Oklahoma, where the high-spirited rivalry between the local farmers and cowboys provides a colourful background against which Curly, a handsome cowboy, and Laurey, a winsome farm girl, play out their love story. 


