Chelsea Boys' Club

The Club is run from converted garages under the World's End Estate and has a Membership of about 200 boys aged between 10 and 18.

Being affiliated to The London Federation of Boys' Clubs a large number of activities are available outside the Borough such as fun, adventure, leadership and sporting week-ends at one or other of two centres situated near Amersham and East Grinstead. The boys are also able to join rock climbing, skiing, sailing and canoeing courses. Within the Club itself we run four football teams, a boxing section, cricket and tennis teams, and, largely due to the present Club Leader's great interest in swimming we have a growing number of enthusiasts for water sports. Our photography section has just re-opened as has the handicraft group, both activities being popular with the boys.
