PALACE ENTRANCES.

There are three entrances to the Palace Gardens, all of which will be open from 3.15 p.m. To avoid delays in arrival and departure guests are advised, if possible, to use the Constitution Hill or Grosvenor Place Gate. These gates are also the most convenient for those arriving or leaving by public transport.

Victoria Underground and British Rail (SR) stations are within a short walking distance of the Grosvenor Place Gate, and Hyde Park Corner Underground station is very near the Constitution Hill Gate. There are numerous bus routes that pass Hyde Park Corner and along Grosvenor Place and Victoria Street.
