


Public transport:
Portsmouth Harbour train station is just 200 metres from our entrance. Coach and bus services stop at The Hard Interchange outside our main gate. The Gosport Ferry and Isle of Wight Catamaran also operate nearby on a regular basis.

By road:

Please note that these fill guickly - we advise using Portsmouth City Council's park-and-ride facilities (Saturday and Sunday only).
