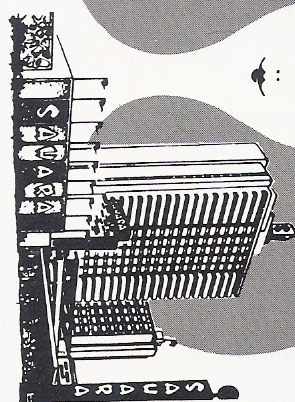

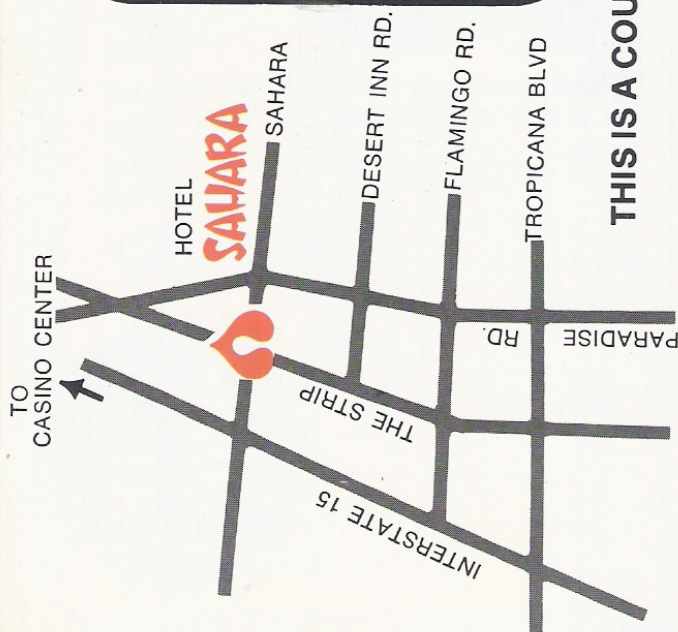

## Las Vegas Tourist Information

### What to Wear

Visitor fashions range from mink coats to mini-skirts . . . from casual dresses to tight capris and heels for the women . . . to sportswear or business suits for the men.

Spring and fall temperatures average in the 70s, allowing cool enough temperatures in the evening for light jackets, sweaters or stoles. While sport clothes for daytime wear are "in," the popular preference for a nocturnal outing is either a business or sports suit ensemble for men and cocktail dresses for the women.

During the summer months the mercury almost daily hits the 100-plus mark and a wear-what-you-like attitude prevails. The desert summer is pleasantly balanced by low humidity (20% or less), making the area's outdoor recreation facilities popular throughout the year.

### How to Tip

The subject of tipping is a very personal one both to the visitor and employees. Below are guidelines to Las Vegas tipping customs. We recommend that you tip above or below the suggested rate depending on the quality and extent of service rendered.

**BELLMEN** — 75c and up. Good rule of thumb is 25c for each additional bag. **CAB DRIVERS** — 50c and up depending on distance travelled and luggage handled. **MAID** — 50c to \$1.00 per day of your stay. **PARKING BOYS** — 50c and up. **ROOM SERVICE** — 15% of bill. **WAITRESSES** — 15% of bill. **POOL BOYS** — 25c to 50c for lounge service.
