City of London Sinfonia and Polyphony return for their annual concert at St John's Smith Square, performing Mozart's ever popular Requiem, together with music for remembrance.

Estonian composer, Arvo Pärt, wrote his *Cantus in Memoriam* for string orchestra and bell as an elegy to mourn the death of the English composer, Benjamin Britten, who in turn composed his *Variations* for string orchestra as a tribute to his teacher the composer, Frank Bridge. Britten also arranged Henry Purcell's simple *Chacony*, for whom he had great musical admiration and we open the concert with the first movement of Purcell's music composed for the funeral of Queen Mary in 1695.

Conducted by Stephen Layton, this concert will feature an array of leading British soloists including baritone Roderick Williams.
