"In 1996, to see and hear actors relive the record of the Nuremberg War Crimes Trial on stage, using nothing but the words of the defendants, is to experience a fresh insight into the great lie that engulfed the world over 50 years ago.

.Richard Norton-Taylor, who edited the Trial to mark Nuremberg's 50th anniversary for the Tricycle Theatre's current production - mounted with meticulous sincerity by director Nicolas Kent and a strong company of actors and designers - has a bit of a thing about "pure truth", and has found an effective means of drawing our attention to it.

.. The naturalistic staging, which reproduces with maximum fidelity the courtroom and its processes, and the defendants' appearance and mien, encourages us to experience the sensations and reactions of the original participants and spectators. Running for two hours without a break, the intensity of the compressed interrogation has a merciless fascination.

.Norton-Taylor and Kent, along with their collaborators, are demonstrating that theatre can reach those parts of the mind apparently cauterised by media coverage, and they do it by highlighting the individual's responsibility for humanity's actions by focusing on the word. The investment of time and concentration needed to watch and hear is repaid with a terribly enhanced understanding of the human capacity to hurt and deny responsibility."





Exactly one year after the tragic events in Srebrenica, under Rule 61 the prosecuting lawyers at the United Nations War Crimes Trial in The Hague laid out their case against the two ex-leaders of the Bosnian Serbs.

The proceedings went almost totally unreported by the British media, as witness upon witness: from a Dutch Colonel in the UN peace-keeping force, to a local Bosnian farmer, to a soldier in the Bosnian Serb Army described the terrible events in the aftermath of the fall of Srebrenica.

The 1996 proceedings in The Hague, exactly 50 years after Nuremberg, investigate the largest massacre in Europe since the Second World War; the evidence demands to be heard.
