

OPERA RARA RECREATES OFFENBACH'S DAZZLING ROMANTIC OPERA

Fantasio, considered one of Offenbach's most beautiful and refined works is a heady cocktail of charm, gracefulness and gentle melancholy, of bad-tempered jokes and poetry, marking Offenbach's crucial step on his way towards The Tales of Hoffmann.

It is among the least known of Offenbach's lyric works, having been almost totally ignored since its very brief run in Paris in 1872. Opera Rara intends to put this right with its studio recording and concert performance using a brand new performing edition of the complete work by music publishers Boosey & Hawkes (edition Keck).

The action takes place in a fairy-tale Munich, between the royal residence and the university, with its liberal-minded students. A young and beautiful princess is set to marry a prince she has never met. Fantasio, in love with the princess, happily seizes the occasion to dress as a jester in order to help and be near her. He climbs the park wall in his disguise and disappears into darkness, towards adventure...

Dr Benjamin Walton, Senior Lecturer in Music at the University of Cambridge. Benjamin Walton's talk will look at the rapid spread of bel canto operas beyond Europe before 1850, often within a few years of their European premieres. To explore how this took place, he will focus in particular on the remarkable example of the first operatic troupe to go all the way around the world, performing operas by Rossini and others in locations from Buenos Aires to Calcutta.
