Yorkshire Watercolour Society

A Short History

The Society has now been formed for five years, and has made good progress. It was started by ten well known artists who decided that we needed a County organisation to represent Yorkshire watercolourists. One sees exhibitions marked "by Yorkshire Artists", but these are actually open exhibitions available to anyone who cares to submit. Ours is the only true organisation representing watercolourists, where membership depends on strict selection by quality of work and residence in Yorkshire. Our membership is limited and we have a long list of applicants waiting to join. We began with a small exhibition of founder members in the Yorkshire Post building in Leeds to coincide with Yorkshire Day, August 1st 1982. This was followed by an exhibition in the Harrogate Art Gallery in February 1983 by all the members at that time. Then we had an exhibition in the Smith Art Gallery, Brighouse in June 1983, so successful we were asked there again in 1986. In November 1983 we had our first exhibition in the House of Commons, sponsored by the Rt. Hon. Roy Mason MP. In August 1984 we had a successful exhibition in the Pannett Gallery in Whitby. In November 1984, due to the success of our first exhibition, we held our second exhibition in the Harrogate Art Gallery.

This proved even more successful than the first. March 1985 saw us having our second exhibition in the House of Commons, again sponsored by the R. Hon, Roy Mason MP. This too was more successful than the first. April 1985 was very important to us. Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Education Committee very kindly allowed us the use of Cannon Hall, Cawthorne, for a permanent exhibition of our current membership's work. This is well worth seeing. It is well displayed in a beautiful Hall which is set in very fine grounds. We have had an exhibition in the Doncaster Art Gallery in September of 1986 followed by our second in Brighouse in 1986. Last year we had the first art exhibition ever at the Monkgate offices of Yorkshire Water in York, which was successful followed by a third exhibition at Doncaster in the Autumn. Our standards are high and we possess some of the finest watercolourists in the County. They come from all over Yorkshire - Bradford, Brighouse, Coverdale in North Yorkshire, Doncaster, File, Harrogate, Hull, Huddersfield, Ilkley, Knaresborough, Otley, Leeds and surrounding districts. Our main object is the promotion of watercolours by Yorkshire artists and to set standards comparable to the London societies. We are also grateful to the assistance provided for the Society by
